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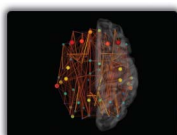
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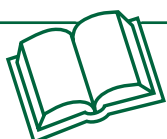


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**Cover image:** An individual's brain network reconstructed using diffusion tensor imaging. From this network measures of local and global connectivity can be computed. See page 1370.
