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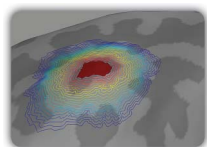
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Cover image: Example of a geodesic distance contour surrounding a cortical lesion overlaid on left hemisphere cortical surface of one RRMS subject. See page 1702.

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
