In the Article “Leisure activity participation and risk of dementia: An 18-year follow-up of the Whitehall II Study” by A Sommerlad et al.¹, the second sentence of the Results section should read, “During 147,774 person-years at risk, 360 incident dementia cases were recorded (incidence 2.4 per 1,000 person-years).” The short version of the article published October 28, 2020 should also have stated “incidence 2.4 per 1,000 person-years.” The authors regret the error.
